A BILL FOR

An Act to amend section three hundred sixty-eight point thirty-four (368.34), Code, 1950, relating to the general powers of cities and towns providing for additional power to purchase and pay for liability and property damage insurance which shall insure against individual personal liability of city employees while in the performance of their duties.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section three hundred sixty-eight point thirty-
2 four (368.34), Code 1950, is amended by adding, following the
3 second paragraph, the following: "Any city or town, including
4 those acting under special charter and under the city manager
5 form of government may purchase and pay the premiums on
6 liability and property damage insurance covering and insuring
7 city employees while in the performance of their duties and
8 operating an automobile, truck, road grader, machinery, or
9 other vehicles owned by the city, which insurance shall insure,
10 cover and protect against individual personal liability the
11 city employees or employee may incur. The amount of insurance
12 a city may purchase shall not exceed five thousand dollars
13 (\$5,000.00) for property damage or five thousand dollars

14 (\$5,000.00) for personal injury or death of one person or ten
15 thousand dollars (\$10,000.00) for personal injury or death of
16 more than one person arising out of a single accident.”
