## A BILL FOR

An Act to appropriate from the general fund of the state the sum of thirty-nine dollars and ninety-four cents (\$39.94) to the agricultural land credit fund for the purpose of refund to Woodbury County for omitted claim.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated to the agricultural  
2 land credit fund established in the office of the treasurer of  
3 state by chapter four hundred twenty-six (426), Code 1950, the  
4 sum of thirty-nine dollars and ninety-four cents (\$39.94) out  
5 of the general fund of the state from funds not otherwise  
6 appropriated, for the purpose of refunding to Woodbury County,  
7 agricultural land credit in that amount which was inadvertently  
8 omitted in the certifications made to the state comptroller for  
9 claims for such refund made for the tax year 1947.

1 Sec. 2. The comptroller is hereby directed to issue his  
2 warrant for said amount, made payable to the county treasurer  
3 of Woodbury County and to mail the same to the county auditor  
4 of that county.

1 Sec. 3. This Act being deemed of immediate importance,  
2 shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage

3 and publication in The Anthon Herald, a newspaper published at  
4 Anthon, Iowa and in The Merville Record, a newspaper published  
5 at Merville, Iowa.
