A BILL FOR

An Act to amend and revise Section three hundred seventeen point nineteen (317.19), Code of 1950, relating to the Road Clearing Fund.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section three hundred seventeen point nineteen
2 (317.19) Code of 1950, is hereby amended and revised as follows:

3 "The board of supervisors in any county may levy against all
4 the taxable property, other than incorporated cities and towns,
5 in said county not to exceed one and one-half mills, the
6 proceeds of which said levy shall be known as the "road clearing
7 fund" and shall be used for no purpose except to cut, burn or
8 otherwise destroy all weeds, second or undergrowth brush on
9 said county trunk and local county roads between the fence rows
10 of such roads thereof in time to prevent reseeding.

11 "Out of said fund so provided for in this section the board
12 of supervisors shall have the power to purchase or hire necessary
13 equipment or to contract with the adjoining landowner to carry
14 out the purposes of this section. However, if said tax is
15 levied, the board of supervisors shall not charge the cost

16 of cutting said weeds to the adjoining owner as provided
17 by Section three hundred seventeen point eighteen (317.18)
18 Code of 1950.”
