A BILL FOR

An Act relating to claims against estates, guardianships or trusts, limiting the time within which action may be taken on such claims, and limiting the time within which action may be taken to contest the final settlement or discharge of an administrator, executor, guardian or trustee.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. All claims or other demands against an estate,
2 guardianship, or trust, or against the legal representatives
3 or fiduciaries thereof, are barred, unless action is taken to
4 contest the final settlement or discharge of the administrator,
5 executor, guardian, or trustee, within five (5) years after the
6 order of final settlement or discharge is entered, whether
7 or not the provisions of sections six hundred thirty-three
8 point forty-six (633.46), six hundred thirty-eight point
9 thirty-six (638.36), four hundred twenty-two point twenty-
10 three (422.23), four hundred twenty-two point twenty-seven
11 (422.27), four hundred twenty-two point fourteen (422.14),
12 six hundred eighty-two point thirty-five (682.35), of the 1950
13 Code of Iowa, have been complied with.

1 Sec. 2. This Act shall apply to all existing orders of
2 settlement or discharge unless action is taken to contest the
3 same within six months after the effective date hereof.
