A BILL FOR

An Act to amend chapter two hundred thirty-seven (237), Code 1950, relating to the definition and licensing of Children's Boarding Homes.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section two hundred thirty-seven point two
2 (237.2), Code 1950, is amended by striking from line three
3 (3), the following: "more than two", and inserting in lieu
4 thereof, the following: "one or more."

1 Sec. 2. Section two hundred thirty-seven point two
2 (237.2), Code 1950, is further amended by striking from lines
3 three (3) and four (4) thereof, the following: "fourteen",
4 and inserting in lieu thereof, the following: "sixteen."

1 Sec. 3. Section two hundred thirty-seven point two
2 (237.2), Code 1950, is further amended by striking from line
3 six (6) thereof, the following: "and", and inserting in lieu
4 thereof, the following: "or."

1 Sec. 4. Section two hundred thirty-seven point two
2 (237.2), Code 1950, is further amended by striking the comma
3 (,) at the end of line eleven (11) thereof, and by striking

4 the words “without compensation” and the comma (,) following
5 said words in line twelve (12) thereof.

1 Sec. 5. Section two hundred thirty-seven point three
2 (237.3), Code 1950, is amended by adding thereto the following:
3 “Applications shall be in writing and in a form prescribed by
4 the board.”

1 Sec. 6. Section two hundred thirty-seven point four
2 (237.4), Code 1950, is amended by striking the comma (,) in
3 line three (3) and inserting in lieu thereof a period (.);
4 and by striking all of said section following the said comma
5 (,) in line three (3) thereof and inserting in lieu thereof
6 the following: “The state board of social welfare shall
7 establish standards for making this determination and may
8 call upon the state department of health and other departments
9 for assistance and advice in formulating standards. The
10 state board may accept the findings of a licensed child placing
11 agency as to the suitability of a private family home in
12 which such agency is providing boarding home care for child
13 or children under its supervision.”

1 Sec. 7. Section two hundred thirty-seven point ten
2 (237.10), Code 1950, is amended by striking all of said section.
