A BILL FOR

An Act to prohibit the participation in motor vehicle races, speed contests, endurance contests and similar tests of skill and endurance by persons who are not licensed as chauffeurs and who have not attained the age of twenty-five years, and to provide penalties for the violation of the provisions of this Act.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. No person shall operate or drive a motor vehicle
2 at any place within this state in any race, speed contest, exhibition,
3 show, exercise, entertainment, meeting or other sport, or in any
4 physical endurance test or contest of man or vehicle, unless such
5 person is at least twenty-five years of age and has in his immediate
6 possession a valid license as a chauffeur issued by the department
7 of public safety of this state.

1 Sec. 2. Any person violating any of the provisions of this Act
2 shall upon conviction be punished by imprisonment in the county jail
3 for a period of not less than seven days nor more than thirty days,
4 or by a fine of not less than twenty-five dollars nor more than one
5 hundred dollars. The sentence imposed under this section shall not
6 be suspended by the court, notwithstanding the provisions of section

7 247.20 or any other provision of statute. Chapter 232 shall have
8 no application in the prosecution of offenses committed in violation
9 of this Act.
