A BILL FOR

An Act to amend various sections of the Code of 1950 to make certain restrictions on minors and offenses against said minors apply to all persons under twenty-one years of age.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Section one hundred twenty-four point twenty
2 (124.20), Code 1950, is amended as follows:
- 3 1. Strike from line fourteen (14) the word "minor" and
4 insert in lieu thereof the words "person under twenty-one years
5 of age".
- 6 2. Strike from line fifteen (15) the word "minor" and insert
7 in lieu thereof the words "such person".
- 8 3. Strike from line seventeen (17) the word "minor" and
9 insert in lieu thereof the words "such person".
- 10 4. Strike from line twenty-one (21) the word "minor" and
11 insert in lieu thereof the words "person under twenty-one years
12 of age".
- 13 5. Strike from line twenty-four (24) the word "minor" and
14 insert in lieu thereof the word "person".
- 1 Sec. 2. Section one hundred twenty-four point twenty-one
2 (124.21), Code 1950, is amended by striking from line one (1)

3 the word “Minors” and inserting in lieu thereof the words “Persons
4 under twenty-one years of age”.

1 Sec. 3. Section six hundred ninety-five point twenty-six
2 (695.26), Code 1950, is amended by striking from line three (3)
3 the word “minor” and inserting in lieu thereof the words “person
4 under twenty-one years of age”.

1 Sec. 4. Section seven hundred twenty-five point eight
2 (725.8), Code 1950, is amended by striking from line three (3),
3 eleven (11), thirteen (13) and fifteen (15) the word “minor”
4 and inserting in each instance the words “person under twenty-
5 one years of age”.

1 Sec. 5. Section seven hundred twenty-six point nine (726.9),
2 Code 1950, is amended by striking from line four (4) the word
3 “minor” and inserting in lieu thereof the words “person under
4 twenty-one years of age”.
