# A BILL FOR

An Act to amend sections three hundred seventy-five point one (375.1) and three-hundred seventy-five point six (375.6), Code 1950, relating to continuance of musical education of children during vacation periods and to municipal bands.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 Section 1. Section three-hundred seventy-five point  
2 one (375.1) is hereby amended as follows:  
3 1. Strike from lines twenty-one (21) and twenty-two (22)  
4 the following words: "and not more than one hundred twenty-  
5 five thousand."

6 2. Strike the period (.) after the word "purposes" in  
7 line twenty-six (26) and adding thereto the following: "and  
8 for the continuance of musical education of children of such  
9 cities having a population of over forty thousand."

1 Sec. 2. Section three-hundred seventy-five point six  
2 (375.6) is amended by striking the period (.) after the word  
3 "commission" in line four (4) thereof and adding the following:  
4 "and in cities having a population of over forty thousand  
5 and not more than one hundred twenty-five thousand, the said  
6 fund shall be administered by the park commissioners as provided

7 for in chapter three hundred seventy (370) and in cities having  
8 a population of one hundred twenty-five thousand or more, said  
9 fund shall be administered by a municipal music board composed  
10 of three members who shall be appointed by the mayor.”
