**A BILL FOR**

An Act to amend section ninety-six point five (96.5), Code 1950, and subsections one (1) and three (3) relating to the disqualification for benefits of an individual who voluntarily quits his job or fails to apply for suitable work or refuses to accept suitable work; to provide for the imposition of a specified number of weeks of disqualification.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 Section 1. That the law as it appears in section ninety-  
2 six point five (96.5), Code 1950, be amended by striking therefrom **all**  
3 of subsection one (1) and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

4 "1. Voluntary quitting. For the week in which he has  
5 left his work voluntarily without good cause and for the  
6 duration of his unemployment which immediately follows, as  
7 determined by the commission according to the circumstances  
8 in each case."

1 Sec. 2. Section ninety-six point five (96.5), subsection  
2 three (3), Code 1950, is hereby amended by striking from line  
3 seven (7) the period (.) and inserting in lieu thereof a  
4 comma (,) and adding the following words: "and such disqualification

5, shall be for the week in which he refused to apply for or accept  
6 suitable work and for the duration of his unemployment which  
7 immediately follows.”
