A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the old age and survivors' insurance system prescribing a method by which public employees after termination of public employment may maintain both current and full coverage thereunder, and to amend Section ninety-seven point forty-five (97.45), Code 1950, relating thereto.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Section ninety-seven point forty-five (97.45),
- 2 Code 1950, is amended by adding to Subsection six (6) a new
- 3 paragraph as follows:
- 4 "He has, following any termination of public employment
- 5 under this chapter, voluntarily paid in quarterly installments
- 6 to the old age and survivors' fund an amount equal to the
- 7 total of the tax or contribution that he and his employer
- 8 would have been required to pay annually had his public
- 9 employment continued, until he has reached the age of sixty-five
- 10 or has accumulated a total of forty quarters of coverage."
- 1 Sec. 2. Section ninety-seven point forty-five (97.45) is
- 2 further amended by striking the period (.) at the end of
- 3 Subsection seven (7) and inserting in lieu thereof a comma
- 4 (,) and adding thereto the following: "or who after termination

5 of his public employment has voluntarily paid taxes and
6 contributions as authorized in Chapter ninety-seven (97), Code
7 1950, for a period of not less than six of the twelve calendar
8 quarters immediately preceding the quarter in which he died.”
