A BILL FOR

An Act to make appropriations to John R. Hattery, Nevada, Iowa,
J. T. Dykhouse, Rock Rapids, Iowa, Morse E. Crosier, Coggon,
Iowa, and Harold F. Nelson, Sioux City, Iowa.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated, out of any moneys
2 in the general fund of the State of Iowa not otherwise appropri-
3 ated, to John R. Hattery, Nevada, Iowa, the sum of nine hundred
4 sixty dollars (\$960), in full settlement of all claims which he
5 may have against the State of Iowa on account of services rendered
6 as a member of the Municipal Statutes Study Committee.

1 Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated, out of any moneys in
2 the general fund of the State of Iowa not otherwise appropriated,
3 to J. T. Dykhouse, Rock Rapids, Iowa, the sum of nine hundred
4 forty dollars (\$940), in full settlement of any claims which he
5 might have against the State of Iowa on account of services rendered
6 as a member of the Municipal Statutes Study Committee.

1 Sec. 3. There is hereby appropriated, out of any moneys in
2 the general fund of the State of Iowa not otherwise appropriated,
3 to Morse E. Crosier, Coggon, Iowa, the sum of twelve hundred
4 dollars (\$1200), in full payment of any claims which he may have

5 against the State of Iowa on account of services rendered as a
6 member of the Municipal Statutes Study Committee.

1 Sec. 4. There is hereby appropriated, out of any moneys in
2 the general fund of the State of Iowa not otherwise appropriated,
3 to Harold F. Nelson, Sioux City, Iowa, the sum of ten hundred
4 twenty dollars (\$1020), in full payment of any claims which he
5 may have against the State of Iowa on account of services rendered
6 as a member of the Municipal Statutes Study Committee.

1 Sec. 5. The state comptroller is hereby authorized to issue
2 warrants to the above named parties in the amounts stated, and the
3 state treasurer is hereby directed to pay the same from any moneys
4 in the general fund of the State of Iowa not otherwise appropri-
5 ated.

1 Sec. 6. This Act shall be in full force and effect from and
2 after approval by the governor as provided by section three point
3 eleven (3.11), Code 1950.
