# A BILL FOR

An Act creating a legislative advisory committee to carry out the provisions of chapter three hundred seven (307), Acts of the Fifty-second General Assembly, chapter sixteen (16), Acts of the Forty-ninth General Assembly, chapter ten (10), Acts of the Fifty-first General Assembly, and chapter seventeen (17), Acts of the Fifty-third General Assembly, relating to the construction of the state office building.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of chapter  
2 nineteen (19), Acts of the 50th General Assembly, there shall  
3 be created a Legislative Advisory Committee consisting of three  
4 members of the Senate and three members of the House of  
5 Representatives to be appointed by the respective presiding  
6 officers of the Senate and House, for the purpose of carrying  
7 out the legislative intent of this act and of chapter sixteen  
8 (16), Acts of the 49th General Assembly, Chapter ten (10), Acts  
9 of the 51st General Assembly, Chapter three hundred seven (307),  
10 Acts of the 52nd General Assembly, and Chapter seventeen (17),  
11 Acts of the 53rd General Assembly.

1 Sec. 2. The term of the Legislative Advisory Committee

2 shall terminate upon the convening of the Fifty-fifth (55) General  
3 Assembly. Any vacancy occurring on the Legislative Advisory  
4 Committee shall be filled by the presiding officer of the House  
5 in the event the vacancy occurs in the membership of said  
6 committee from the House of Representatives, and by the Lieutenant  
7 Governor, in the event the vacancy occurs in the membership of  
8 said committee from the Senate.

9 In carrying out the provisions of this Act, chapter seventeen  
10 (17), Acts of the 53rd General Assembly, chapter three hundred  
11 seven (307) in the 52nd General Assembly, chapter sixteen (16)  
12 in the 49th General Assembly, and chapter ten (10) of the 51st  
13 General Assembly, the Executive Council of the State of Iowa and  
14 the Legislative Advisory Committee shall meet jointly at such  
15 places as may be determined by the Executive Council, and in  
16 determining all matters coming before said meetings it shall  
17 require a majority vote of the members of the joint committee  
18 of the Executive Council and of the Legislative Advisory Committee.

19 The Legislative Advisory Committee shall meet and organize  
20 immediately following sine die adjournment of the Fifty-fourth  
21 General Assembly, and at the same time and immediately following  
22 its organization, meet with the Executive Council in order that  
23 the committee and council may advise on carrying out the  
24 provision of this Act, and the provisions of chapter seventeen  
25 (17) of the 53rd General Assembly, chapter three hundred seven  
26 (307) of the 52nd General Assembly, chapter ten (10) of the 51st  
27 General Assembly and chapter sixteen (16), Acts of the 49th

28 General Assembly.

1     Sec. 3. Each member of the Legislative Advisory Committee  
2 shall be entitled to actual necessary hotel and traveling expenses  
3 incurred in the discharge of his duties, upon an itemized  
4 certification of the amounts due, filed with the comptroller  
5 for audit, and in payment thereof the comptroller shall issue  
6 warrants on the state office building fund, from which a  
7 sufficient amount is hereby set aside for this purpose. In  
8 addition, each member of such Legislative Advisory Committee  
9 shall receive such compensation for time spent in the discharge  
10 of his duties as may be allowed by the General Assembly next  
11 convening.

1     Sec. 4. Insofar as chapter nineteen (19), Acts of the  
2 50th General Assembly is in conflict with this Act, the same  
3 is hereby repealed.

1     Sec. 5. This act being deemed of immediate importance  
2 shall be in full force and effect from and after its publication  
3 in the Guttenberg Press, a newspaper published at  
4 Guttenberg, Iowa, and in the Daily Times,  
5 a newspaper published at Davenport, Iowa.
