A BILL FOR

An Act relating to deductions from salaries or wages of governmental employees in fulfillment of any subscription payments to any authorized insurance corporation for group hospital and surgical insurance, group health and accident insurance and group life insurance.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Any employee or employees of the state, or
2 of any county, city, or town, or of any institution supported
3 in whole or in part by public funds, or any subdivisions
4 thereof, may authorize the deduction from his or their salary
5 or wages of the amount of his or their subscription payments
6 to any insurance corporation licensed and authorized to sell
7 group hospital and surgical insurance, group health and
8 accident insurance and group life insurance, in this state.
9 The governing body of the state, or of the county, city or
10 town, or of any institution supported in whole or in part by
11 public funds, or any subdivisions thereof, may authorize
12 deductions from the salaries or wages of employees subscribing
13 to any such group hospital and surgical insurance, group health
14 and accident insurance or group life insurance plans, the

15 entire cost of which may be contributed by the employee.
16 The authorization by an employee or employees for deductions
17 from his or their salaries or wages shall be evidenced by
18 a written request signed by the employee directed to and filed
19 with the treasurer of the state, county, city or town, or
20 of any institution supported in whole or in part by public
21 funds, or any subdivisions thereof, and said treasurer is
22 authorized to draw and deliver checks in favor of the insurance
23 corporation stipulated in such authorization for the amount
24 covering the sum total of the deductions authorized. The
25 foregoing provisions are not to be deemed an assignment of
26 salaries or wages.
