## A BILL FOR

An Act to amend chapter one hundred nine (109),  
Code 1950, relating to the trapping of beaver  
under permit issued by the conservation commission.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

- 1 Section 1. Chapter one hundred nine (109), Code  
2 1950, is amended by adding thereto the following:  
3 "1. When beaver shall at any time, in any locality, be  
4 causing substantial damage to public or private property,  
5 the commission may issue to any person, as provided herein,  
6 a permit to take and sell beaver. Such permit shall specify  
7 the number, the time and the place where and the method by  
8 which the beaver may be taken, provided however, that no  
9 permit shall be required of any one destroying beaver  
10 causing damage to his private property.  
11 "2. The permittee shall report to the commission within  
12 ten days after the taking of any beaver, the number taken  
13 and submit the skins and such other portions of all such  
14 beaver for inspection as may be required by the permit.  
15 Thereupon, if all requirements in the permit have been complied

16 with, the commission or its appointed representative shall  
17 issue and affix to each beaver skin a distinctive tag,  
18 stamp, or seal. Such tag, stamp, or seal must remain affixed  
19 to each skin until finally processed. The permittee shall  
20 pay the commission a fee of one dollar for each tag, stamp,  
21 or seal so issued. It shall be unlawful for any person to  
22 buy, sell, or transport any beaver skins which are untagged  
23 as provided by this section. The commission shall keep a  
24 record of each such tag, stamp, or seal issued, to whom  
25 issued, and the date of issue.

26 “3. Any person who shall unlawfully take, possess,  
27 transport, sell, or otherwise dispose of any beaver, or any  
28 part thereof, or who shall violate any of the provisions of  
29 this section shall be punished as provided in section  
30 one hundred nine point thirty-two (109.32).”
