## A BILL FOR

An Act to amend sections seven hundred seventy-five point five (775.5), and seven hundred seventy-five point six (775.6), Code 1950, relating to fees for an attorney appointed by the court to defend in a criminal case.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 Section 1. Section seven hundred seventy-five point five  
2 (775.5), Code 1950, is amended by striking from lines six (6)  
3 through ten (10) thereof the following:

4 "twenty dollars per day for the time actually occupied in  
5 court in the trial of defendant. If the prosecution be for  
6 any other felony, he shall receive the sum of ten dollars in  
7 full for services." and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

8 "forty dollars per day for time actually occupied in court  
9 in the trial of defendant and for time spent in preparing for said  
10 trial. If the prosecution be for any other felony, or indictable  
11 misdemeanor, he shall receive the sum of twenty dollars per day  
12 for time actually occupied in court in the trial of defendant  
13 and for time spent in preparing for said trial."

1 Sec. 2. Section seven hundred seventy-five point six  
2 (775.6), Code 1950, be amended by striking the period from the

end thereof and adding thereto the following:

“and that the time stated was actually spent in the trial and preparation of the case.”.
