A BILL FOR

An Act to provide staggered terms for commissioners of memorial buildings and monuments designed to commemorate the service rendered by soldiers, sailors, and marines of the United States; and to amend chapter thirty-seven (37), Code 1950, relating thereto.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section thirty-seven point nine (37.9), Code
2 1950, is amended by adding at the end thereof the following:

3 "The terms of such commissioners shall be staggered so that
4 the terms of no more than two commissioners shall expire in
5 any one year. In order to effect this purpose, the appointing
6 authority, when making first appointments to a new commission,
7 shall appoint one commissioner for a one year term, two
8 commissioners for two year terms, and two commissioners for
9 three year terms. Thereafter all appointments, other than for
10 filling vacancies, shall be for three year terms."

1 Sec. 2. Wherever, prior to the effective date of this
2 Act, commissioners have been appointed under the provisions of
3 section thirty-seven point nine (37.9), Code 1950, the appointing
4 authority shall appoint, upon expiration of the terms of

5 commissioners holding office on the effective date of this
6 Act, one commissioner to serve for a one year term, two
7 commissioners to serve for two year terms, and two commissioners
8 to serve for three year terms. Thereafter all appointments
9 shall be for three year terms. (Temporary.)
