A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the payment of expenses incurred under
the Uniform Criminal Extradition Act.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section seven hundred fifty-nine point
2 twenty-four (759.24), Code of Iowa 1950, is hereby amended
3 and revised to read as follows:

4 "All necessary and actual expenses incurred by any
5 agent or agents appointed by the Governor under Section
6 seven hundred fifty-nine point twenty-two (759.22),
7 and all other necessary and actual expenses incurred in
8 returning a prisoner or prisoners to this State under this
9 Chapter shall be paid out of the County Treasury of the
10 County wherein the crime is alleged to have been committed;
11 provided, however, that in those cases where a prisoner
12 has escaped from the State penitentiary or reformatory,
13 such expenses shall be paid by the State out of funds not
14 otherwise appropriated, and in those cases where a prisoner
15 has been paroled to the Board of Parole and has broken the
16 terms of his parole, such expenses shall be paid as provided

17 in Chapter Two hundred forty-seven (247).”

1 Sec. 2. This Act being deemed of immediate importance
2 shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage
3 and publication in the, a newspaper
