A BILL FOR

An Act to amend chapter two hundred fifty-nine (259), Code 1950,
relating to vocational rehabilitation.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Chapter two hundred fifty-nine (259), Code 1950,
2 is hereby amended by adding the following new sections:
3 "1. The state board may, in its discretion, acquire,
4 establish, operate and maintain vocational rehabilitation centers
5 and workshops to carry out the purposes of this chapter.
6 "2. The state board shall make and adopt rules, regulations,
7 and standards for the establishment, operation and maintenance,
8 government and control of rehabilitation centers and workshops
9 established pursuant to this article, including such rules,
10 regulations and standards as may be necessary for cooperation
11 under and compliance with any existing or future federal statutes
12 pertaining to grants-in-aid for rehabilitation programs and
13 centers.
14 "3. The following words and phrases used in this chapter
15 shall, for the purposes of this chapter, have the meanings
16 respectively described to them in this section except in those
17 instances where the context clearly indicates a different

18 meaning :

19 “a. ‘State Board’ is the state board for vocational
20 the vocational rehabilitation division.

21 “b. The term ‘Rehabilitation Center’ is a facility
22 operated for the purpose of assisting in the rehabilitation
23 of persons disabled in industry or otherwise which provides one
24 or more of the following types of services: (1) testing,
25 fitting, or training in the use of prosthetic devices; (2)
26 prevocational or conditioning therapy; (3) physical,
27 corrective or occupational therapy; (4) adjustment training,
28 or evaluation or control of special impairments; or, in which
29 a coordinated approach is made to the physical, mental, and
30 vocational evaluation of disabled persons and an integrated
31 program of physical restoration and prevocational or vocational
32 training is provided under competent professional supervision
33 and direction.

34 “c. ‘Workshop’ means a place where any manufacture or
35 handiwork is carried on and which is operated by a public
36 agency or by a private corporation or association, no part of
37 the net earnings of which inures or may lawfully inure to the
38 benefit of any private shareholder or individual, or by a
39 cooperative association, for the primary purpose of providing
40 remunerative employment to severely disabled persons who cannot
41 be absorbed in the competitive labor market.

42 “d. ‘Prosthetic Appliance’ means any artificial device
43 necessary to support or take the place of a part of the body
44 or to increase the acuity of a sense organ.”
