## A BILL FOR

An Act to amend sections three hundred fifty-eight point sixteen (358.16), three hundred fifty-eight point eighteen (358.18), three hundred fifty-eight point twenty (358.20), three hundred fifty-eight point twenty-one (358.21) and three hundred fifty-eight point twenty-two (358.22), Code 1950, providing for the imposition of a tax for the retirement of bonds of a sanitary district, and in general relating to the powers and financing of sanitary districts organized under the provisions of chapter three hundred fifty-eight (358), Code 1950.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 Section 1. Section three hundred fifty-eight point  
2 sixteen (358.16), Code 1950, is hereby amended by inserting  
3 after paragraph one (1) of said section the following:  
4 "The board of trustees, however, may upon such petition  
5 of property owners representing at least twenty-five per cent  
6 (25%) of the valuation of property not included within the  
7 district as constituted which seeks benefit from the operation  
8 of such sanitary district, include such property and the area  
9 involved within the limits of such sanitary district, and such  
10 added areas shall be subject to the same taxation as other  
11 portions of the district."

12 Further amend said section by adding thereto the  
13 following paragraph:

14 “The board of trustees of such sanitary district may,  
15 however, upon petition of the council or governing body of any  
16 incorporated town within the sanitary district, contract with  
17 such city or town to undertake the operation of local municipal  
18 sewage facilities as part of the functioning of the sanitary  
19 district and make an agreement with such municipality for the  
20 levying of additional sewer or sewage disposal taxes, which  
21 taxes shall be levied by the municipality as now provided by  
22 law.”

1 Sec. 2. Section three hundred fifty-eight point eighteen  
2 (358.18), Code 1950, is hereby amended by striking from  
3 lines four (4) and five (5) thereof the words “for corporate  
4 purposes” and inserting in lieu thereof the following: “for  
5 the purpose of paying the administrative costs of such district,  
6 and/or for the payment of deficiencies in special assessments”.

1 Sec. 3. Section three hundred fifty-eight point twenty  
2 (358.20), Code 1950, is hereby amended by adding thereto the  
3 following:

4 “The provisions of chapter three hundred ninety-three  
5 (393), Code 1950, shall apply to sanitary districts organized  
6 under this section insofar as they are applicable.”

1 Sec. 4. Section three hundred fifty-eight point twenty-  
2 one (358.21), Code 1950, is hereby amended by adding thereto  
3 the following:

4     “The proceeds of any bond issue made under the provisions  
5 of this section shall be used only for the purpose of acquiring,  
6 locating, laying out, establishing and construction of drainage  
7 facilities, conduits, treatment plants, pumping plants, works,  
8 ditches, channels and outlets of such capacity and character  
9 as may be required for the treatment, carrying off and disposal of  
10 the sewage and industrial wastes and other drainage  
11 incidental thereto of such district, or to repair, change,  
12 enlarge and add to such facilities as may be necessary  
13 or proper to meet the requirements present and future  
14 for the purposes aforesaid. Proceeds from such bond  
15 issue may also be used for the payment or special  
16 assessment deficiencies. Said bonds shall be payable in  
17 not more than twenty (20) annual installments and at  
18 interest not exceeding five per cent (5%) per annum, and  
19 shall be made payable at such place and be of such form  
20 as the board of trustees shall by resolution designate.  
21 Any sanitary district issuing bonds as authorized in  
22 this section is hereby granted authority to pledge the  
23 future avails of a tax levy not exceeding five (5) mills  
24 per annum to the payment of the principal and interest  
25 of such bonds after the same come due, and the power to  
26 impose and certify said levy is hereby granted to the  
27 trustees of sanitary districts organized under the pro-  
28 visions of this chapter.

2 twenty-two (358.22), Code 1950, is hereby amended by  
3 inserting after the figures "391" in line forty-four  
4 (44), a comma (,) and the figures ", 391 A".

1 Sec. 6. This Act being deemed of immediate importance  
2 shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage  
3 and publication in The Milford Mail, a newspaper published at  
4 Milford, Iowa, and The Clear Lake Mirror, a newspaper pub-  
5 lished at Clear Lake, Iowa.
