A BILL FOR

An Act assenting to the provisions of the act of congress entitled "An act to provide for the acquisition, construction, expansion, rehabilitation, conversion, and joint utilization of facilities necessary for the administration and training of units of the Reserve components of the Armed Forces of the United States, and for other purposes", approved September 11, 1950, and to make an appropriation therefor.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. The State of Iowa hereby assents to the
2 provisions of the act of congress entitled "An act to
3 provide for the acquisition, construction, expansion,
4 rehabilitation, conversion, and joint utilization of
5 facilities necessary for the administration and training of
6 units of the Reserve components of the Armed Forces of the
7 United States, and for other purposes," approved September
8 11, 1950 (Public No. 783, 81st Congress), and the adjutant
9 general is hereby authorized and empowered to perform such
10 acts as may be necessary to carry out the purposes set
11 forth in said act of Congress, in compliance with said act
12 and with rules and regulations promulgated thereunder.

1 Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated out of the
2 general fund of the state of Iowa for the period beginning
3 on the effective date of this Act and ending June 30, 1953,
4 the sum of two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000.00) or so
5 much thereof as may be necessary for the acquisition,
6 construction, expansion, rehabilitation and conversion of
7 facilities for the administration and training of units of
8 the Iowa National Guard and the Iowa State Guard as provided
9 in Section 1 of this act.

1 Sec. 3. This act being deemed of immediate
2 importance shall take effect and be in full force from
3 and after its passage and publication in the
