**A BILL FOR**

An Act making appropriations for payment of miscellaneous expense incurred or authorized by the Fifty-fourth General Assembly.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated out of any funds in  
2 the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the following sums,  
3 or so much thereof as may be necessary in payment of miscellaneous  
4 expenses incurred or authorized by the Fifty-fourth General Assembly:

5 A. C. Gustafson, Chief Clerk of the House,  
6 for postage and miscellaneous expenses after  
7 adjournment. (This shall be in addition  
8 to postage left over in the House post  
9 office after the session has adjourned).....\$ 150.00

10 Carroll A. Lane, Secretary of the Senate,  
11 for postage and miscellaneous expenses  
12 after adjournment. (This shall be in  
13 addition to postage left over in the Senate  
14 post office after the session has adjourned)..... 100.00

15 Executive Council for telephone, telegraph,  
16 supplies, postage and miscellaneous expense

1    Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated a sum sufficient to pay  
2 the per diem compensation made necessary by House Concurrent  
3 Resolution No. 26 for services required of officers and employees  
4 of the Fifty-fourth General Assembly after final adjournment.

1    Sec. 3. There is hereby appropriated to the custodian of  
2 public buildings and grounds of the state of Iowa from the general  
3 fund of the state of Iowa, not otherwise appropriated, to be  
4 expended under the authority of the Executive Council, an amount  
5 necessary to cover the cost of the following repairs to the capitol,  
6 adjacent buildings and grounds as approved by the Legislative  
7 Improvement and Advisory Committee and by the adoption of the  
8 joint report of said committee by joint action of the Fifty-fourth  
9 General Assembly: The installation of two boilers and replacement

10 of breeching and other equipment specified by the Brown Engineering  
11 Company of Des Moines, the rebuilding of the east masonry wall of  
12 the boiler room of the heating plant, repairs to steam lines and  
13 Johnson Service Control equipment, replacement of the sidewalks  
14 between Grand Avenue and East Walnut Street on both sides of the  
15 street leading to the new office building and the Amos Hiatt School  
16 Building, repairs to the west steps at the State House leading  
17 from the driveway to East Ninth Street, repairs to stonework and  
18 caulking of the outside construction of the Capitol Building,  
19 repainting of the rotunda, repairs to the lunettes in the rotunda  
20 on the second floor, carpentry work and painting in the building,  
21 new roofs for the heating plant and the Amos Hiatt School Building,  
22 rewiring the lights on the Capitol extension grounds and streets,  
23 renewal of five windows on the west side of the House Chamber and  
24 five windows on the west side of the Senate Chamber, draperies  
25 for both the House and Senate Chambers, and the repair of the seats  
26 in the balcony of the House Chamber. All funds hereunder appropriated  
27 shall be expended only for the purposes herein set out and only  
28 after the plans and cost of such equipment and improvements has  
29 had the express approval of the Budget and Finance Control Committee.

1     Sec. 4. This Act being deemed of immediate importance shall  
2 be in full force and effect after its passage and publication in  
3 The Harlan News Advertiser, a newspaper published at Harlan, Iowa,  
4 and the Atlantic News-Telegraph, a newspaper published at Atlantic,  
5 Iowa.
