A BILL FOR

An Act relating to hunting and fishing upon cultivated or inclosed lands and waters.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Section seven hundred fourteen point twenty-five
- 2 (714.25), Code 1962, is hereby amended by striking from line ten
- 3 (10) of such section the words "not more than ten dollars" and
- 4 inserting in lieu thereof the words "not less than ten dollars
- 5 and not more than one hundred dollars".

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 4

The increase in the possible fine for each offense from \$10 to a possible \$100 will deter hunters from failing to obtain permission.

- 1 Amend House File 4, section one (1), lines four (4) and
- 2 five (5) by striking the words "not less than ten dollars
- 3 and".
