A BILL FOR

An Act relating to homicide resulting from the operation of motor vehicles.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Chapter three hundred twenty-one (321), Code 1962, is hereby
2 amended by adding thereto the following new sections:

1 Section 1. When the death of any person ensues within one
2 year as a proximate result of injury received from the operation
3 of any motor vehicle in wanton or reckless disregard for the
4 safety of others or while intoxicated, the person so operating
5 such vehicle shall upon conviction be guilty of homicide by motor
6 vehicle.

1 Sec. 2. Any person convicted of homicide by motor vehicle
2 shall be punished by imprisonment in the penitentiary for a
3 period not to exceed five (5) years or by a fine of not less than
4 one hundred (100) dollars nor more than one thousand (1000)
5 dollars, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 19

This bill establishes the crime of homicide by motor vehicle and provides a penalty therefor.
