An Act to amend sections one hundred fifty-five point two (155.2) and one hundred fifty-five point six (155.6), Code 1962, regarding the right of unlicensed persons to fill prescriptions.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Section one hundred fifty-five point two (155.2),
- 2 Code 1962, is hereby amended by striking all of subsection one
- 3 (1) and by renumbering the remaining subsections.
- 1 Sec. 2. Section one hundred fifty-five point six (155.6),
- 2 Code 1962, is hereby repealed and the following inserted in lieu
- 3 thereof:
- 4 "No unlicensed person or licensed pharmacist shall allow
- 5 anyone who is not a licensed pharmacist to sell or dispense any
- 6 drugs, or medicines, or fill the prescriptions of licensed
- 7 physicians, dentists or veterinarians, except a person who is
- 8 registered with the board of pharmacy examiners and is in good
- 9 standing therewith pursuant to the practical experience
- 10 requirements of this chapter and the rules and regulations of the
- 11 board of pharmacy examiners and unless the same be done under the
- 12 immediate personal supervision of a licensed pharmacist. All
- 13 drugs and medicines sold, exposed or offered for sale shall be
- 14 under the immediate personal supervision of a licensed pharmacist
- 15 at all times except for temporary absences. However, during a
- 16 period of temporary absence of a licensed pharmacist no drugs or

17 medicines shall be sold or offered for sale in the pharmacy

18 except proprietary medicines and domestic remedies."

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 26

With the advent of so many new powerful drugs and drugs which are dangerous if not properly used and controlled, it is imperative in order to protect the health of the public that only trained and experienced persons handle, sell and dispense such medication.
