A BILL FOR

An Act to make appropriations to the state department of social welfare to be used for medical assistance to the aged.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated out of the general
- 2 fund of the state of Iowa from funds not otherwise appropriated
- 3 to the state department of social welfare the sum of four
- 4 million (4,000,000) dollars for each year of the biennium
- 5 beginning July 1, 1963, and ending June 30, 1965, to be used
- 6 for medical assistance to the aged as provided by chapter two
- 7 hundred forty-nine A (249A) of the Code.

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 30

The funds appropriated by this bill would be matched by federal funds under Public Law 86-778 and would provide funds to implement a program for medical assistance to the aged who are not on old age assistance, but whose income and resources are insufficient to meet the costs of necessary medical care and services.
