A BILL FOR

An Act relating to insurance protection for volunteer civil defense workers while engaged in civil defense activities.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Section twenty-eight A point seven (28A.7),
- 2 Code 1962, is amended by adding thereto the following new
- 3 sentence:
- 4 "Said boards and councils are hereby authorized to purchase
- 5 and pay the premiums on hospital, medical, term-life, and
- 6 liability insurance insuring volunteer civil defense workers
- 7 while in the performance of civil defense work, civil defense
- 8 training, practice alerts, and exercises."

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 33

This bill would permit county boards, school boards and city and town councils to insure volunteer civil defense workers while engaged in civil defense activities. Such insurance would cover hospital and medical expense, provide for liability coverage and term life insurance.

- 1 House File 33 is hereby amended by inserting in line 4,
- 2 immediately following the word "councils", the words "in cities
- 3 or counties of one hundred eighty thousand or more population".
