An Act relating to the licensing and the annual inspection of county homes.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Chapter two hundred fifty-three (253), Code
- 2 1962, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following
- 3 section:
- 4 "County homes shall be exempt from the licensing provisions
- 5 of section one hundred thirty-five C point ~~twenty-two~~ ^{six} (135C.22⁶)
- 6 of the Code, but shall be annually inspected by the state fire
- 7 marshal and the commissioner of public health or their duly
- 8 authorized representatives who shall report their findings to
- 9 the county grand jury and the board of supervisors."

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 48

County homes are presently governed by the same law as nursing homes. This bill exempts county homes from the nursing-home statute the same as state institutions.

- 1 Amend section one (1) by striking all of line five (5)
- 2 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
- 3 "of section one hundred thirty-five C point six (135C.6)".
