A BILL FOR

An Act relating to holders for registration certificates of
motor vehicles.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section three hundred twenty-one point thirty-two
2 (321.32), Code 1962, is hereby amended by inserting in line six
3 (6) after the word "furnished" the words "or approved".

1 Sec. 2. Section three hundred twenty-one point one hundred
2 seventy-two (321.172), Code 1962, is hereby repealed.

1 Sec. 3. This Act, being deemed of immediate importance, shall
2 be in full force and effect from and after its publication in the
3 Sidney Argus Herald, a newspaper published at Sidney,
4 Iowa, and the Shenandoah Evening Sentinel, a news-
5 paper published at Shenandoah, Iowa.

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 71

Under present law, owners of vehicles are required to display a certificate of registration in a holder provided by the motor vehicle department. Many of the late model domestic and foreign cars are so constructed that the type of holder furnished will not permit the registration to be "plainly seen" from the exterior of the car as provided by law. This bill would permit the department to attempt to furnish holders which will permit compliance with the law and to approve certificate containers sold by private persons for use in motor vehicles. An owner may then be able to get a holder from the department or purchase an approved holder which fits his car so that he may comply with the law.
