A BILL FOR

An Act relating to public health nurses.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Section one hundred forty-three point one
- 2 (143.1), Code 1962, is hereby amended by inserting in line six
- 3 (6) after the word "advisable." the following new sentence:
- 4 "The board of supervisors of any county, the council of any
- 5 city or town, or the school board of any school district, or
- 6 any of them acting in co-operation, may contract with any non-
- 7 profit nurses' association for public health nursing service."

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 83

Some doubt has arisen as to whether or not county supervisors, city councils or school boards may lawfully enter into contracts with nonprofit nurses' associations in order to secure public health nursing service. This bill would specifically authorize this desirable activity.
