A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the use of parking meter revenue.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Section three hundred ninety point eight (390.8),
- 2 Code 1962, is hereby amended by striking from line forty (40)
- 3 the word "twenty-five" and inserting in lieu thereof the word
- 4 "fifty (50)".

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 89

This bill would raise from 25 percent to 50 percent the percentage of the total parking meter revenue which may be used to pay the cost of maintenance and repair of meters, the collection of meter taxes, the enforcement of traffic laws in the parking meter district, purchase and installation costs of other parking or control devices installed on such portions of streets as are equipped with parking meters.
