A BILL FOR

An Act to permit all school districts to hold biennial elections.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section two hundred seventy-seven point one
 2 (277.1), Code 1962, is amended by adding the following thereto:
 3 "Any school district may by board action elect to have their
 4 elections every two (2) years."

1 Sec. 2. Section two hundred seventy-seven point twenty-
 2 four (277.24), Code 1962, is amended by adding after the word
 3 "more" in line thirteen (13) the following words " , or districts
 4 which have elected to have biennial elections,".

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 97

This bill is to allow all communities to have elections every two years instead of the present yearly elections. This should result in a saving to the smaller communities that the cities over 125,000 population now have.
