A BILL FOR

An Act to make an additional transfer of fees, taxes, interest and penalties imposed under chapter four hundred twenty-two (422), Code 1962, to the division of motor vehicle registration of the department of public safety for the purpose of purchasing supplies and materials and for the cost of manufacture of motor vehicle registration plates at the prison industries.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. On the effective date of this Act the treasurer
2 shall transfer one hundred seventy-five thousand (175,000) dollars
3 to the division of motor vehicle registration of the department of
4 public safety for the purpose of purchasing supplies and materials
5 and for the cost of manufacture of motor vehicle registration plates
6 at the prison industries as provided in section four hundred
7 twenty-two point sixty-two (422.62), Code 1962. Any amount
8 unexpended for this purpose on October 31, 1963, shall be credited
9 to the road use-tax fund.

1 Sec. 2. This Act being deemed of immediate importance shall
2 be in full force and effect from and after its passage and
3 publication in The Lakeview Resort, a newspaper published at
4 Lakeview, Iowa, and in the Eldora Herald-Ledger, a newspaper
5 published at Eldora, Iowa.

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 107

The 59th General Assembly provided in chapter 230, Acts of the 59th General Assembly, for a transfer of funds for purchasing supplies and materials and for the cost of manufacture of motor vehicle registration plates at the prison industries. Such amounts have proved to be inadequate and additional funds are needed in order to complete production of motor vehicle registration plates for the 1964 registration year. The inadequacies have been created by increased registrations of motor vehicles and increased costs of manufacture and for materials both for 1963 and 1964 production

registration years. Present computations based on the 1964 allotment figures indicate that sufficient funds are not available for a revalidation program except by using an emblem in the upper right hand corner of the windshield. Therefore, additional funds must be provided if 1964 registration plates are to be available on December 1, 1963, for commencement of sales for the 1964 registration year.
