## A BILL FOR

An Act relating to bounties on wild animals.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

- 1 Section 1. Section three hundred fifty point one (350.1),
- 2 Code 1962, is hereby amended by striking all of line ten (10).
- 1 Sec. 2. Section three hundred fifty point two (350.2), Code
- 2 1962, is hereby amended by adding the following:
- 3 "For each red or gray fox, two (2) dollars."

### EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 117

This bill does only one thing to the law as it is now enacted. It simply changes the fox bounty from a mandatory to an optional bounty. Along the southern counties, many of the counties have quit paying a bounty on foxes, as so many have been brought in from the state of Missouri and joining states. It has been very difficult for the county auditors to determine the origin of the foxes caught and brought in for bounty payment.

- 1 Amend House File 117 as follows:
- 2 1. By adding at the end of section one the following:
- 3 "Further amend said section by striking all of lines
- 4 five (5) and six (6)".
- 5 2. By adding at the end of section two the following:
- 6 "For each adult wolf, ten dollars
- 7 For each cub wolf, four dollars".
