## A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the compensation of councilmen in certain cities.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 Section 1. Section three hundred sixty three B point nine

2 (363B.9), Code 1962, is amended as follows:

3 1. By striking from subsection five (5), lines two (2) and  
4 three (3), the words "one hundred" and substituting in lieu  
5 thereof the word "ninety".

6 2. By striking all of subsection six (6) and inserting in  
7 lieu thereof the following:

8 "In cities having by such census a population of ninety  
9 thousand or more, for the mayor, not to exceed twelve thousand  
10 five hundred dollars and for each councilman not to exceed  
11 eleven thousand dollars."

### EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 140

This bill permits Cedar Rapids to pay a salary not to exceed \$12,500 for a mayor and \$11,000 for councilmen.
