A BILL FOR

An Act relating to civil rights.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section seven hundred thirty-five point one
2 (735.1), Code 1962, is hereby amended by inserting in line
3 eight (8) following the word "shops," the words "beauty shops,
4 nursing homes, barber colleges, schools of beauty training,".

1 Sec. 2. Section seven hundred thirty-five point two
2 (735.2), Code 1962, is hereby amended by striking lines nine
3 (9), ten (10) and eleven (11) and enacting the following in
4 lieu thereof:

5 "fine of not less than one hundred (100) dollars nor more
6 than three hundred (300) dollars, or imprisonment in the
7 county jail not to exceed thirty (30) days."

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 144

This bill expands the scope of civil rights legislation and alters the penalty for violation.
