**A BILL FOR**

An Act relating to the deposit of litter in or upon lands and waters under the jurisdiction of the state conservation commission.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

- 1 Section 1. Section one hundred eleven point forty-three
- 2 (111.43), Code 1962, is hereby amended by adding thereto the
- 3 following:
- 4 "It shall be unlawful for any person to throw or deposit
- 5 in or upon any waters or land under the jurisdiction of the
- 6 state conservation commission any glass, glass bottle, nails,
- 7 tacks, wire, cans, trash, garbage, rubbish, litter, offal or
- 8 other debris. Debris deposited on property by flood waters
- 9 or other natural causes may be redeposited by the owner or
- 10 his agent in the stream from which it came and such act
- 11 shall not constitute an offense under this section."

**EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 169**

The purpose of this bill is to protect persons lawfully using and enjoying the state lands and waters under the jurisdiction of the Conservation Commission and the fish and game inhabiting from injury resulting from the deposit of litter in the same manner as section 321.369 protects persons and animals upon the public highways. It is the further purpose of the bill to prevent the public lands and waters from being turned into unsightly dump grounds.
