A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the method of arriving at maximum benefits payable on permanent partial disability, permanent total disability, temporary total disability, and healing period.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Section eighty-five point thirty-four (85.34),

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 195

This bill removes the arbitrary dollar and cents limits per week on payments to the Workmen's Compensation Act and provides for a payment of two-thirds of a person's earnings in weekly benefits.
