A BILL FOR

An Act to amend section ninety-six point four (96.4), Code 1962, so as to eliminate the requirement that a claimant serve a waiting period before becoming eligible for employment security benefits.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Section ninety-six point four (96.4), Code 1962,
- 2 is hereby amended as follows:
- 3 1. By striking all of subsection four (4), including para-
- 4 graphs "a", "b", and "c".
- 5 2. By renumbering subsection five (5) as subsection four
- 6 (4).
- 1 Sec. 2. This Act shall be effective with respect to claims
- 2 the benefit years of which commence on or after July 4, 1963.

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 200

This bill eliminates the requirement that a claimant is not eligible for unemployment benefits during the first seven days of unemployment.
