A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the duties of the sheriff in the execution of the death penalty.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Section seven hundred ninety-two point nine
- 2 (792.9), Code 1962, is hereby amended by adding thereto the
- 3 following: "However, if the judgment was rendered in a county
- 4 other than the county where the crime was committed, then the
- 5 sheriff of such county where the crime was committed, or
- 6 his deputy, shall execute such judgment."

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 201

The purpose of this bill is to provide that when judgment is rendered in a county other than the county where the crime was committed, for instance on a change of venue, the execution of the judgment shall be carried out by the sheriff of the county where the crime was committed.
