**A BILL FOR**

An Act relating to the imposition of special parking restrictions in cities and towns in aid of snow removal operations and to provide the manner for posting notice thereof.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

- 1 Section 1. Section three hundred twenty-one point two
- 2 hundred thirty-seven (321.237), Code 1962, is amended by
- 3 adding at the end thereof the following:
- 4 "When a city or town has adopted an ordinance which
- 5 prohibits standing or parking of vehicles upon a street
- 6 or streets during any time when snow-removal operations are
- 7 in progress and before such operations have resulted in the
- 8 removal or clearance of snow from such street or streets,
- 9 signs bearing the legend 'No Parking During Snow Removal'
- 10 posted as hereinbefore provided shall be deemed sufficient
- 11 notice of the existence of such restrictions."

**EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 215**

The purpose of this bill is to give a municipality the authority to designate, by ordinance, certain streets as "no parking" streets during the time when snow removal operations are necessary. Signs would have to be erected along these streets to give proper notice to the motorist.
