A BILL FOR

An Act relating to applications for marriage licenses.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section five hundred ninety-five point four
2 (595.4), Code 1962, is hereby amended by striking from lines
3 seventeen (17), eighteen (18), nineteen (19) and twenty
4 (20) the following: "no license shall be issued until the
5 expiration of three days from the date of filing the
6 application. After the expiration of three days from the
7 date of filing".

1 Sec. 2. Section five hundred ninety-five point seven
2 (595.7), Code 1962, is hereby amended by striking from line
3 five (5) after the word "return" all of the remainder of the
4 section.

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 228

This is a bill to eliminate the three-day waiting period for a marriage license; also the provision for notification of county clerks of court and other authorities regarding such marriage.
