## A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the terms of office for members of the  
Iowa civil defense administration.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

- 1 Section 1. Section twenty-eight A point two (28A.2),
- 2 Code 1962, is hereby amended by striking from line nine (9)
- 3 the words "The governor", also all of lines ten (10) through
- 4 seventeen (17) and enacting in lieu thereof:

5 "From and after July 1, 1963, the appointments of the  
6 members of the administration shall be made as follows:

- 7 1. Three members shall be appointed for three-year terms,
- 8 and
- 9 2. Three members shall be appointed for two-year terms,
- 10 and
- 11 3. Three members shall be appointed for one-year terms,
- 12 and beginning July 1, 1964 and on July 1 of each succeeding
- 13 year, three members shall be appointed or reappointed for
- 14 three-year terms; provided, however, that upon the death,
- 15 disability, or resignation of any member, the governor shall
- 16 appoint a person to serve for the unexpired term of the
- 17 vacating member."

### EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 237

This bill would stagger the terms of office of the members of the civil defense administration so there would always be six holdover members, thus avoiding a totally new board at any one time.

HOUSE FILE 237

1 Amend the title to House File 237 by striking the words "the  
2 terms of office for members of".  
3 Amend House File 237 by striking all after the enacting clause  
4 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:  
5 "Section 1. Section twenty-eight A point two (28A.2), Code  
6 1962, is hereby repealed, and the following inserted in lieu  
7 thereof:  
8 "There is hereby established an advisory committee of nine (9)  
9 members, to be appointed by the governor. For the first committee  
10 three (3) members shall be appointed to serve three (3) year terms,  
11 three (3) members shall be appointed to serve two (2) year terms,  
12 and three (3) members shall be appointed to serve one (1) year  
13 terms. Thereafter all appointments shall be for three (3) year  
14 terms. Members of the committee shall be appointed without regard  
15 to political party affiliation.  
16 Each member of the advisory committee shall be further identi-  
17 fied as responsible for one (1) of the nine (9) state advisory  
18 committee civil defense functions as follows: (1) State Communi-  
19 cations; (2) State Construction; (3) State Agriculture and Economic  
20 Controls; (4) State Government; (5) State Health and Welfare;  
21 (6) State Industry; (7) State Manpower; (8) State Fuel and Energy;  
22 and (9) State Transportation.  
23 The committee shall submit one (1) name to the governor as  
24 its recommendation for the office of director of civil defense."  
25 Sec. 2. Section twenty-eight A point three (28A.3), Code 1962,  
26 is hereby amended by inserting in line sixteen (16) after the  
27 word 'the' the words 'director of the'.  
28 Sec. 3. Section twenty-eight A point four (28A.4), Code 1962,  
29 is hereby amended as follows:  
30 '1. By striking from line four (4) the word "administration",  
31 and inserting in lieu thereof the words "governor, who shall give  
32 due weight to the recommendation of the advisory committee in  
33 making his selection, but shall not be bound by such recommendation  
34 and".  
35 2. By striking from line fourteen (14) the word "administration"  
36 and inserting in lieu thereof the word "governor. The director  
37 shall serve for four (4) years."  
38 Sec. 4. Section twenty-eight A point five (28A.5), Code 1962,  
39 is hereby amended by striking from line two (2) the word 'admin-  
40 istration' and inserting in lieu thereof the word 'governor'."
