A BILL FOR

An Act to amend section four hundred eleven point six (411.6), Code 1962, relating to benefits under the retirement systems for policemen and firemen.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section four hundred eleven point six (411.6),
 2 Code 1962, subsection one (1), paragraph "a", is hereby amended
 3 by striking from lines nine (9), ten (10) and eleven (11) of
 4 said paragraph the words "the age of fifty-five and shall have
 5 served twenty-two years or more in said department," and insert-
 6 ing in lieu thereof the following: "the following ages and
 7 shall have served the following number of years or more in
 8 said department:

9 Age	Years of service
10 fifty-five	twenty-two
11 fifty-four	twenty-three
12 fifty-three	twenty-four
13 fifty-two	twenty-five
14 fifty-one	twenty-six
15 fifty	twenty-seven."
