## A BILL FOR

An act to permit specially qualified high school students to attend a college or university for advanced courses and to pay tuition therefor.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

- 1 Section 1. The board of any school district may by mutual
- 2 agreement with any college or university, permit any specially
- 3 qualified high school student to attend advanced courses of
- 4 instruction therein and to pay to said college or university
- 5 tuition agreed upon from the funds of the school corporation.
- 6 The state board of regents may by rule permit such students
- 7 to attend any institution of higher learning under their juris-
- 8 diction. Credit earned in any such course at a college or
- 9 university may be applied toward credit for high school gradua-
- 10 tion.

### EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 248

This bill would permit certain high school students to get advanced training in a college or university in courses not offered in his home district.
