A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the salaries of clerks and bailiffs of the
municipal courts.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Section six hundred two point forty-nine (602.49),
2 Code 1962, is hereby amended as follows:
3 1. By striking from line five (5) thereof the word "four"
4 and inserting in lieu thereof the word "five".
5 2. By striking from line seven (7) thereof the word "five"
6 and inserting in lieu thereof the word "six".
7 3. By striking from line nine (9) thereof the word "five"
8 and inserting in lieu thereof the word "six".
9 4. By striking from line twelve (12) thereof the word
10 "seven" and inserting in lieu thereof the word "eight".
11 5. By striking from line nineteen (19) thereof the word
12 "four" and inserting in lieu thereof the word "five".
13 6. By striking from line twenty (20) thereof the word
14 "four" and inserting in lieu thereof the word "five".
15 7. By striking from line twenty-three (23) thereof the first
16 word "five" and inserting in lieu thereof the word "six".
17 8. By striking from line twenty-five (25) thereof the word
18 "six" and inserting in lieu thereof the word "seven".
19 9. By striking from line thirty-one (31) thereof the word
20 "annually".

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 277

The purpose of this bill is to assure that the compensation that municipal court clerks and bailiffs receive will bear some realistic relationship to the cost of living and the general economic scale, prevailing at this time, there having been no such compensation adjustment for a period of four years prior to this time.
