A BILL FOR

An Act to amend chapter one hundred fifty-seven (157), Code 1962,
relating to cosmetology shop licenses.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Chapter one hundred fifty-seven (157), Code 1962,
 2 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following new section:
 3 "Any person who performs or holds himself out as willing
 4 to perform any cosmetology service to the general public without
 5 having first obtained a license to practice cosmetology, or at
 6 a place not licensed as a cosmetology shop or inspected by the
 7 state department of health, with or without compensation, shall
 8 be guilty of a misdemeanor."

1 Sec. 2. Said chapter one hundred fifty-seven (157), Code
 2 1962, is hereby further amended by adding thereto the following
 3 additional section:

4 "No person shall operate a cosmetology shop without first
 5 obtaining a license from the department of health, division of
 6 cosmetology, the fee for which shall be for an original cosmetol-
 7 ogy shop license, twenty-five dollars with an annual renewal
 8 license fee of five dollars. Cosmetology shall be practiced
 9 only by licensed cosmetologists in cosmetology shops inspected
 10 and licensed by the department of public health of the state."
