# A BILL FOR

An Act relating to temporary extensions of motor vehicle operators' licenses in certain instances.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

1 Section 1. Section three hundred twenty-one point one  
 2 hundred ninety-six (321.196), Code 1962, is amended by  
 3 adding at the end thereof the following:  
 4 "Any resident of Iowa holding a valid operator's or  
 5 chauffeur's license who is temporarily absent from the  
 6 state, or incapacitated, may, at the time for renewal for  
 7 such license, obtain from the sheriff of the county of his  
 8 residence a form to apply for a temporary extension of his  
 9 license. The department upon receipt of such application  
 10 form properly filled out shall, upon a showing of good cause,  
 11 issue a temporary extension of such license for not to  
 12 exceed six months. The department shall prescribe and  
 13 furnish such forms to each county sheriff."

1 Sec. 2. This Act being deemed of immediate importance  
 2 shall be in full force and effect from and after its pub-  
 3 lication in the Oskaloosa Daily Herald, a newspaper pub-  
 4 lished at Oskaloosa, Iowa, and The Garner Leader and  
 5 Signal and Herald, a newspaper published at Garner, Iowa.

### EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 298

This bill would permit the department of public safety to continue to issue temporary extensions of drivers' licenses to persons temporarily absent from the state, or incapacitated, when their licenses are about to expire. This is particularly true for wives of service personnel in foreign countries.
