A BILL FOR

An Act relating to the issuance of temporary permits by the Iowa natural resources council.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

1 Section 1. Section four hundred fifty-five A point one
 2 (455A.1), Code 1962, is hereby amended by adding thereto the
 3 following:
 4 "Temporary permit' means a permit issued by the council with-
 5 out notice or hearing. A temporary permit shall be issued for a
 6 specified purpose and for a limited period of time."

1 Sec. 2. Chapter four hundred fifty-five A (455A), Code 1962,
 2 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following new section:
 3 "The council may, without notice or hearing, issue a temporary
 4 permit to store or withdraw water. The temporary permit shall be
 5 effective immediately upon application and approval of the coun-
 6 cil. Before issuing a temporary permit, the council must deter-
 7 mine that the storage or withdrawal under such temporary permit
 8 will not be detrimental to the public interest. The application
 9 shall state the purpose for which the water is to be stored or
 10 withdrawn and shall state the period of time for which the permit
 11 is needed. Upon the issuance of a temporary permit under this
 12 section, the council shall specify the period for which the
 13 temporary permit shall be effective. If the person to whom such
 14 temporary permit is issued meets all the requirements of section

- 15 four hundred fifty-five A point nineteen (455A.19) of the Code
16 during the time the temporary permit is effective, the water
17 commissioner may issue a permanent permit. A temporary permit
18 issued under this section shall not be renewed.”

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 327

The purpose of this bill is to authorize the Iowa natural resources council to issue temporary permits for storage or withdrawal of water. Such permits may only be issued by the Iowa natural resources council for a specified purpose and for a limited period of time. Such permits cannot be renewed.
