A BILL FOR

An Act to amend section five hundred seven point four
(507.4), Code 1962, relating to the maximum per diem
of insurance examiners.

Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:

- 1 Section 1. Section five hundred seven point four (507.4),
- 2 Code 1962, is hereby amended by striking the word "fifty" from
- 3 line twenty-one (21) thereof and substituting therefor the word
- 4 "eighty".
- 5 Sair section is further amended by striking the words "one
- 6 hundred eighty" from lines twenty-two (22) and twenty-three
- 7 (23) thereof and substituting therefor the words "two hundred".

EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 331

The expense of examinations is paid by the insurance companies and not the state. The National Association of Insurance Commissioners is attempting to standardize the costs of examinations and this bill would put Iowa examiners on a par with examiners from other states.
