## A BILL FOR

An Act relating to theft of traps and fur.

*Be It Enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Iowa:*

- 1 Section 1. If any person shall steal, take and carry away any
- 2 trap, or remove any fur-bearing animal from a trap without the
- 3 consent of the owner, he is guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be
- 4 fined not less than one hundred (100) dollars nor more than one
- 5 thousand (1,000) dollars or sentenced to thirty (30) days in the
- 6 county jail, or both such fine and imprisonment. All fines col-
- 7 lected under this section shall go to the fish and game protec-
- 8 tion fund. Conservation officers are hereby empowered to enforce
- 9 this section.

### EXPLANATION OF HOUSE FILE 337

This bill establishes a specific law against stealing traps and fur and authorizes conservation officers to assist enforcement. Any fines collected would go to the game protection fund.
